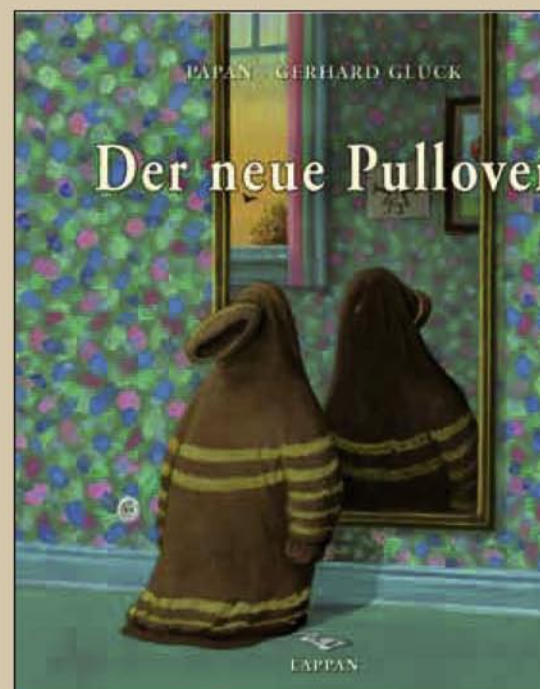
How Tina Got Lost in Her New Pullover
